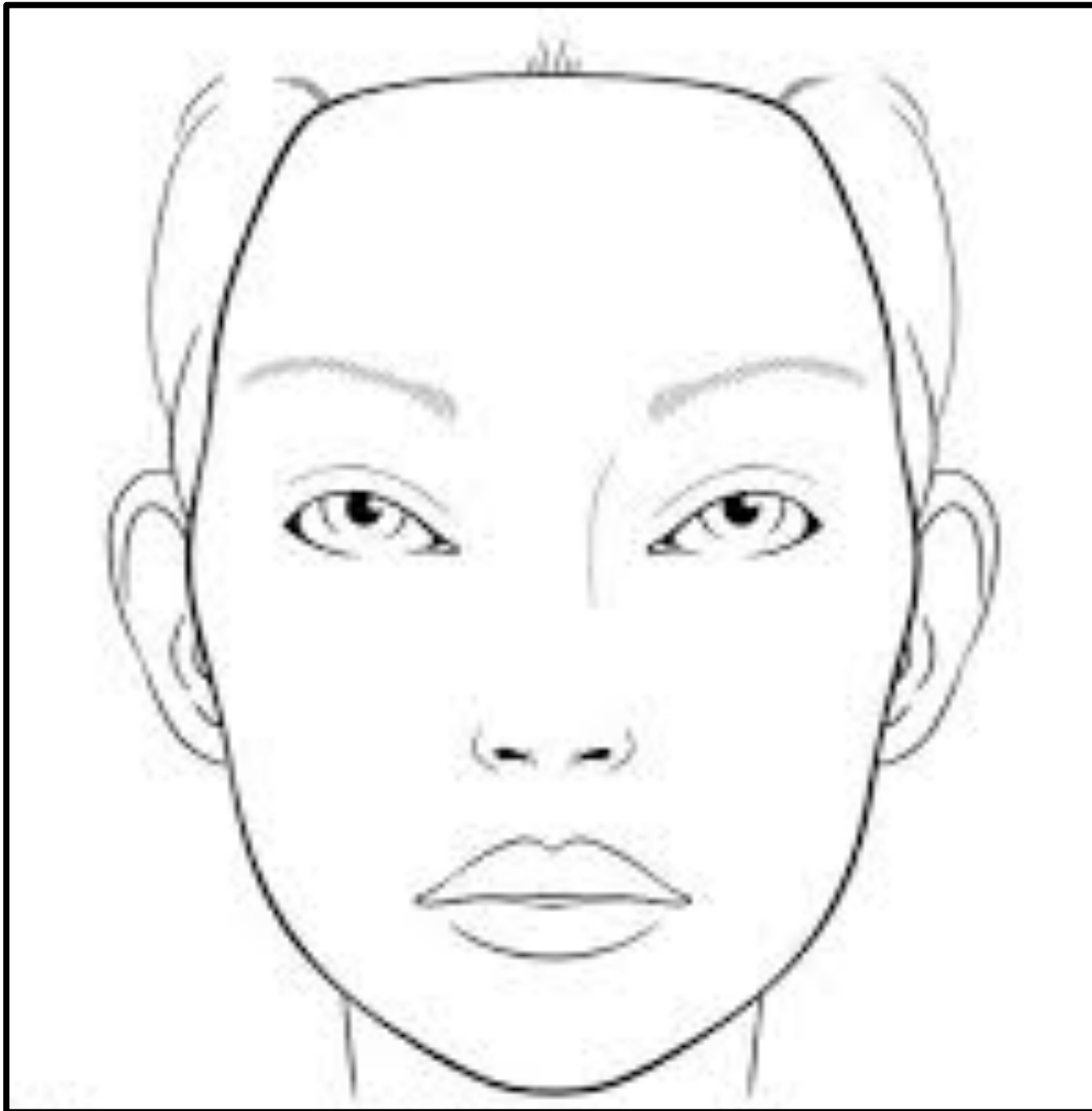


CREATURE CREATOR WORKSHEET!

Use this as a template for your design! This is your Practice Face!



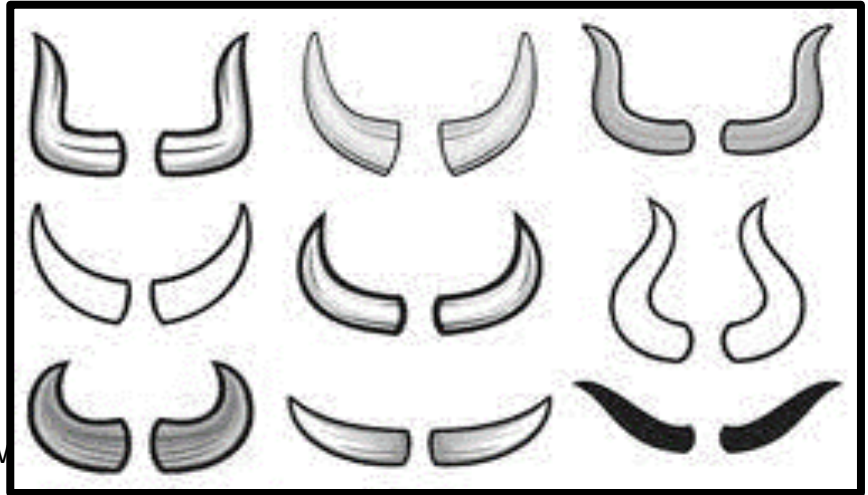
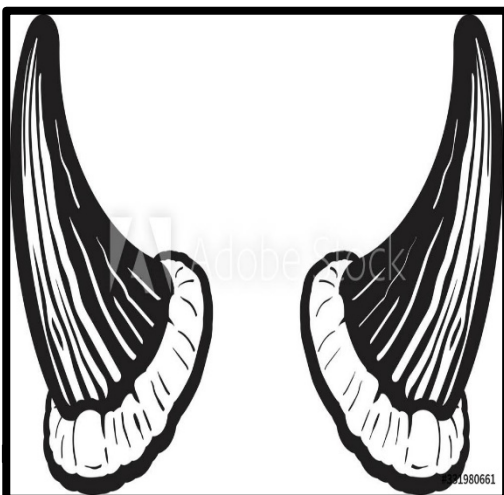
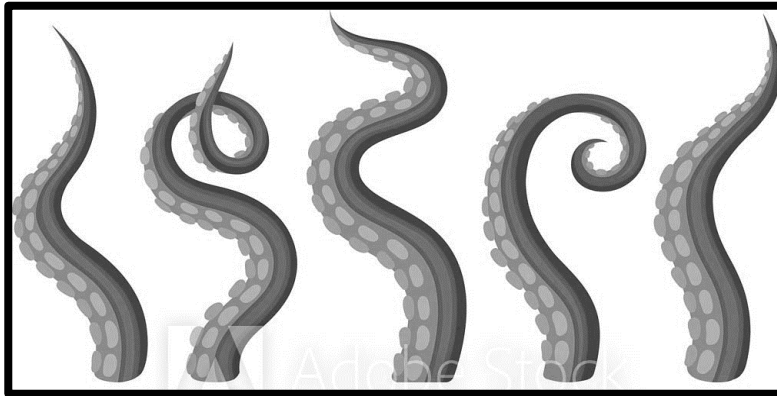
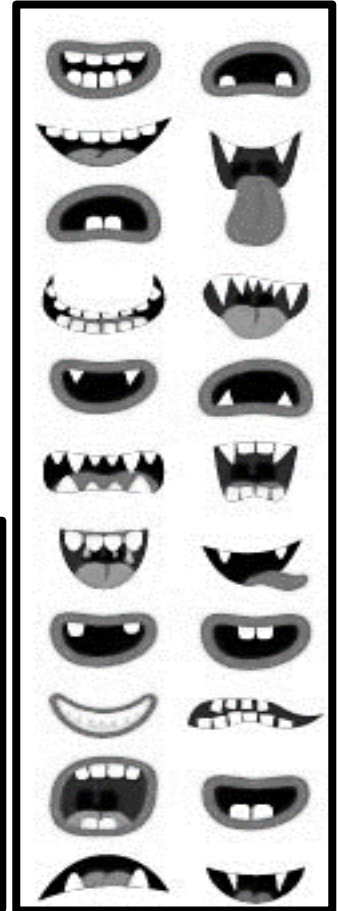
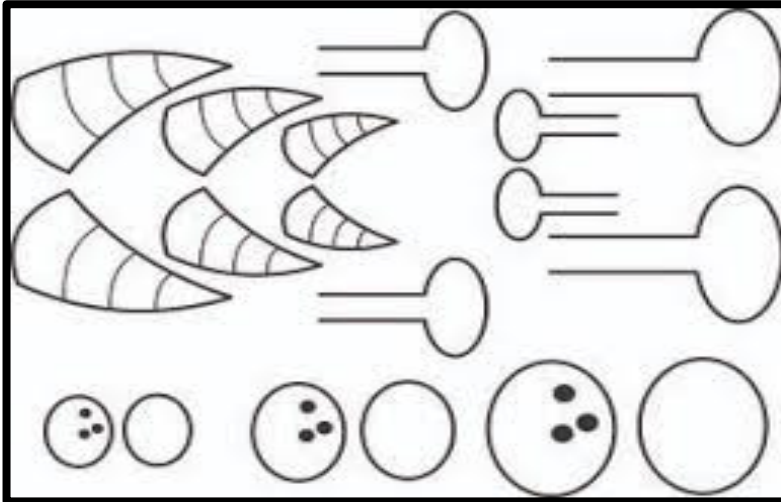
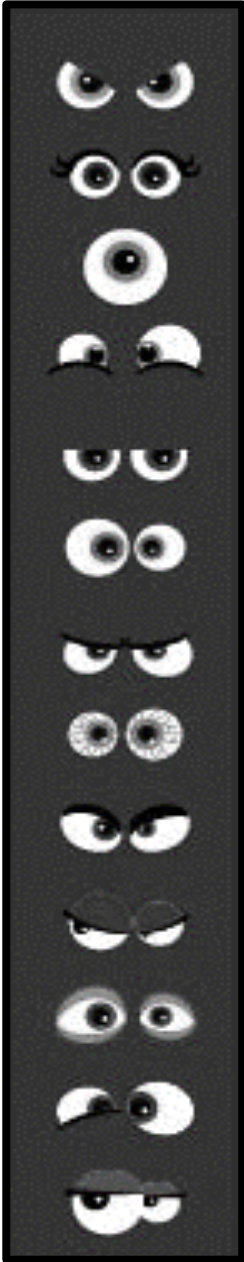
CHOOSE YOUR MASK SHAPE!



- Choose one of the basic mask shapes above! (Circle It)
- Draw the outline of the shape on your practice face!

ADD CREATURE ELEMENTS TO YOUR MASK!

Draw them on your practice sheet!



CHOOSE YOUR COLORS!

Now that you've got the shapes and elements on your mask, you have to decide what color you want! Color in your mask to get your final design

MAKE YOUR FACE PAINT!

Mix together the following ingredients!

- 1 cup water
- 1 cup cornstarch
- 1 cup flour
- 1 cup lotion
- 1/4 teaspoon vegetable oil
- Food coloring
- Spoon
- Bowl
- Containers

Directions

- Add water, cornstarch, flour and lotion to a bowl.
- Mix together ingredients and make sure the paint consistency is to your liking. If you want to thicken, add more cornstarch. To thin out the mixture, add water.
- Add food coloring to make your colors!
- Store in an airtight container.

PAINT YOUR FACE!

(You will need to use small brushes or sponges for this step.)

- Start with the outline of the mask!
- Fill in your mask color!
- Outline your creature elements
- Paint in your creature elements color
- Outline your entire mask to give it shape! (Use a dark color)

(NOTE: You may need to work in layers with this paint for saturation. When dry, the paint will start to crack and flake off for easy clean up!)
